##  <br> FPll Fibonacci Scarf designed by Laura Bryant

One Size: approx $6^{\prime \prime} \times 66^{\prime \prime}$ exclusive of fringe

## Materials:

4 Symphony:
1 A (Plumberry)
1 B (Lapis)
2 C (Olivine)
Needles size 10 \& 13 or size to get gauge

Gauge: in garter stitch on \# 10 needle, 14 sts \& 28 rows $=4$ "

Scarf: With A and larger needle, CO 240 sts. Knit every row and follow stripe pattern below. At the end of every row, wrap yarn around an 8 " piece of cardboard and tie back on itself to continue; or attach new yarn leaving $8^{\prime \prime}$ tails. Loops will be cut later for fringe. Work until there isn't enough B to make a repeat. Finish with 6 rows C, then 2 rows A. BO with larger needle. Clip fringe evenly.

## Stripe Repeat:

2 rows A
4 rows B
6 rows C


Fibonacci numbers determine a stripe repeat that allows you to easily play with color. Here we have chosen three richly saturated Layers ${ }^{T M}$ colors for a pleasing and easy to make garter scarf.

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
