

FP16 Big Chenille Cowl

Size: 1 (2) approx. 11" x 28" (9" x 32")

Materials: 1 Prism Big Chenille 24" circ needle size 10

Gauge: in K 3, P 3 rib, 9 sts & 16 rows = 4"

Cowl is worked from the top down.

CO 54 (66) sts. K 3, p 3 for 1 row.

Join for circular knitting, taking care not to twist stitches.

Work as established to approx. 9 (11)".

Work extended bind off: knit 1 (YO, pass st over YO, knit 1, pass 1st st over) repeat to end.

*Big, lush chenille makes a cozy, comfy cowl of grand dimensions.* One skein in a big rib works up in a couple of nights. Rich, tonal layers colors reflect subtle glints of jeweled light. Two size options allow for a slightly longer cowl that could be doubled. Shown is size 1 in Carnelian.
