

PRISM

FP10 Plume Scarf designed by Laura Bryant

One size

Materials:

2 skeins Plume
Needles size 11

Garner stitch

CO 15 sts. Work to end of skein. Knot second skein to first and bury ends (Plume is very slippery and the knot will ensure that the ends stay put). Work to end of second skein and BO all sts.

To make scarf more furry, “liberate” the hairs with a blunt tipped needle where they are loops. You can also tumble in the dryer on low for a few minutes, or shake the scarf vigorously. If the hairs are slightly crimped from being in a ball, simply wave some steam at them and they will relax.



Our fun scarf couldn't be easier: simply knit every row of this fantastic faux fur. Extremely generous in size, ours is shown doubled up above, in the color Antique.

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
