

Sizes: One size approx 14" x 60"

Materials: Wrap calls for much more yarn than is actually used to gain color variety. There is enough yarn left from the Misso skirt to make the wrap as pictured. You can also reduce the number of colors used.

10 Prism Euroflax Sportweight Linen
 1 skein each Pearl A, Ebony B, Juniper C, Aegean D,
 Bittersweet E, Violetta F, Rosamund G, Honeydew H,
 Hibiscus I, Orchid J (Or your choice)
 Needles size 7 or size to get gauge
 Stitch markers

Gauge: In Chevron stitch, 21 sts (17 + 4) = 3 ¼" wide

Chevron pattern: 17 sts + 4; 34 rows total

Row 1: K2, * ssk, k6, (k1, yo, k1 in same st) k6, k2 tog, pm*,
 rep **4 more times, k2.

Row 2: Purl.

Wrap: With C, CO 89 sts.

Work Chevron Patt in Garter St (knit row 2) for 4 rows.

Work row 1 & 2 in Chev Patt in the following row sequence:

13 C - 8 D - 5 E - 3 F - 2 G - 1 H - 1 I - 1 J.

Domino Pattern: Carry yarn loosely across back.

(Row 1 decreases from 17 to 16 sts between markers.)

Row 1: K 2 B, (k4 A, k4 B, k4 A, k3 B, K2 tog B) 5 times,
 k2 A—84 sts.

Row 2: Purl all sts as est.

Row 3: K2 B, (k4 A, k4 B, k4 A, k4 B) repeat to last two sts, k2 A.

Row 4: Repeat row 2.

Return to Chevron Pattern: (Increase row restores stitch count.)

After increase row, return to Chevron Patt, and work all in the following stripe sequence:

1 J - 1 I - 2 H - 3 G - 5 F - 8 E - 13 D.

Increase row: K2, * k7, (k1, yo, k1 in same st) k6, k2 tog*,
 repeat ** 5 times, k2—140 (157, 174) sts.

Next row: K2, purl to last two sts, k2.

Repeat Domino Pattern.

Work Chev Patt with B for 6 1/4", increasing in first row.

Repeat Domino Pattern.

Repeat B for 6 1/4" alternated with Domino Pattern for a total of 4 sections B.

Repeat Domino Pattern.

Return to Chevron Pattern in the following sequence:

13 E - 8 F - 5 G - 3 H - 2 I - 1 J - 1 C - 1 D.

Repeat Domino Pattern.

Return to Chevron Pattern in the following sequence:

1 E - 1 D - 1 C - 2 J - 3 G - 5 H - 8 G - 13 F.

Work 4 rows Chevron Pattern in Garter Stitch (knit row 2).

BO all sts.



Brigitte's homage to Missoni makes a grand, dramatic statement that is the perfect accent to a coordinating skirt or jacket, topped off with a more subtle solid tee. There is plenty of yarn left from the skirt to make the wrap; if you have leftovers from a jacket you simply need to get a skein each of black and white.
