



8601 Goldilocks Poncho

The ultimate textural accessory: our Goldilocks poncho in Baby Bear size (left) takes only 1 full skein of Stuff with 4 Plumes for a lush ruffle at both neck and bottom edge. Worked circularly from the top down. Shown in Violetta Layers Stuff.

Mama Bear, right, adds 1 skein of Symphony to the mix to make a longer piece, shown in Ebony.

Papa Bear, lower right, uses 1 skein of added Madison instead of the Symphony for a longer yet piece. Shown in Pueblo.



8602 Swing City Skirt

Inspired by the poncho, why not make a skirt? With lovely fullness and great swing, the bottom ruffle kisses your legs with every step! Bonus: a drawstring waist allows you to wear this as a poncho, too!

Sizes: P/S (M, L) finished hip approx. 38 (42, 46)''

Shown in Slate, right.

Materials:

- 1 (1, 2) Full +
- 1 (1, 0) Half Skein Stuff
- 2 (2, 3) Symphony
- 2 (2, 3) Plume

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8603 Mustang Top

Size: 1 (2)
 Finished bust approx:
 32 (36)'' unstretched;
 38 (42)'' stretched

Materials:
 1 (1) Full Stuff (A)
 0 (1) Half Stuff (A)
 2 Symphony (B)

It's the Mustang Top because it's convertible!
 Wear it long and lean with a subtle collar, left, or turn it upside down for a fuller collar and shorter body, right.
 Let the cowl drape or pull it over your shoulders for yet another look.

Worked in the round in any type of Stuff, Symphony is added for economy to stretch Stuff.
 Shown in Pueblo.



8604 On the Fringe Cowl

One size: Approx 68'' circumference X 6'' wide

Materials:
 1 Full Stuff

Here's what the Fringe Folk say: More is better!

Take a full skein of Stuff and cut lengths of fringe as you knit this infinity cowl in the round, and then add the extra fringe on to one long edge.

The cowl is generous enough that two loops makes a loosely draped cowl (near right) and three loops is abundantly luxurious (left).

Shown in Autumn Wild Stuff.





8605 Twister Cowls

Sizes: 1 (right)
2 (left)

finished circumference
66 (66)” x 4 (8)”

Materials:

- 1 (0) Half Stuff A
- 0 (1) Full Stuff A
- 1 (2) Plume B

Yet another clever way to get a lot of bang for your knitting time: our infinity Twister Cowls in two sizes.

Whether you opt for a full skein of Stuff and two Plumes in the same colorway as at left in Winterfell, or use a half skein and one



contrasting Plume as above in Rosamund Layers Stuff and Mango Plume, the results are stunning and sure to please. Cowls are worked circularly in garter stitch (knit one round, purl one round).

Half skein cowl has Plume on one side only.

Cowls can be worn either double looped, as at top/ or triple looped, below.

The twist comes into play as you loop the cowls and the Plume edges twist in and out of the folds.
